

Take down fake covers, Time tells Trump group

On display at U.S. President's golf clubs
 Time Magazine said on Wednesday it has asked the Trump Organization to take down a mock front cover celebrating Donald Trump's business record that is on display in several of the President's golf clubs.
 Spotted by scribe
 A Washington Post journalist spotted the Time cover during a visit to one of the clubs and, after investigating, reported that it was a fake, and was framed on the walls of at least four other venues.
 "TRUMP IS HITTING ON ALL FRONTS . . . EVEN TV!" screams the headline of the cover dated March 1, 2009, with a subhead reading: "Donald Trump: The 'Apprentice' is a television smash!" According to a spokeswoman for the U.S. magazine, Time has asked the Trump Organization, currently run by the President's adult sons, to take down the covers.
 The President has been at loggerheads with much of the U.S. media since last year's campaign, accusing them of peddling "fake news" about him.

Aadhaar-PAN linkage must from July 1

The Income Tax Department on Wednesday issued a notification making it mandatory for all those eligible for an Aadhaar card to link it to their Permanent Account Number (PAN) from July 1, 2017.
 The notification also said that the Aadhaar numbers must be submitted to the Principal Director General of Income Tax (Systems) or the Director General of Income Tax (Systems). However, the notification did not specify how this was to be done, said Sonu Iyer, Tax Partner and People Advisory Services leader at EY India.
 About 2.07 crore taxpayers have already linked their Aadhaar with PAN, according to the government. There are currently about 25 crore PAN card holders in the country and 115 crore Aadhaar holders.

GST won't impact J&K's status: Drabu
