**Sales of Maruti, Honda soar**

GST rollout, better monsoon forecast to spur sales  
 May was a mixed bag for domestic car sales with Maruti Suzuki, Honda and Ford posting strong double-digit growth, while Toyota Kirloskar Motor suffered a decline. Even as carmakers said consumers postponed sales due to uncertainties on prices before GST, they expected the new indirect tax regime and a better monsoon forecast to aid sales in the coming months.  
 Market leader Maruti Suzuki posted 15% growth to more than 1.30 lakh units compared to the same month of the previous year. The growth was driven by a whopping 66% jump in sales of utility vehicles.

**BJP, Akalis seek action in Dalit attack case**

Leaders of the Shiromani Akali Dal and the Bharatiya Janata Party approached the National Commission for Scheduled Castes (NCSC) on Thursday seeking swift action against those who attacked a Dalit and harassed his wife at Bagga village in Majithia in April.  
 SAD leader Bikram Singh Majithia and BJP leader Vineet Joshi met NCSC Director Raj Kumar here and complained against the authorities for failing to arrest those accused of beating and stripping a Dalit as well as outraging the modesty of his wife.  
 Mr. Majithia said it had been 15 days since the victims submitted a complaint to the NCSC.
